All parts must be designed specifically for racing karts and any modifications must be noted and inspected by the scrutineer on duty. It is the kart owner(s) or the owners' guardian(s) responsibility to ensure the kart meets the safety standards and complies with all class racing specifications. Spot checks will be made throughout the day and penalties may be imposed for karts that do not meet the requirements.

Neck brace: in sound condition and fastens securely. Required for Juniors/Cadets/Bambinos, recommended for all drivers.		Engine stop switch: Correctly fitted in reach of driver and marshal, marked with ON/OFF and working correctly	
<b>Boots:</b> Purpose designed for kart racing and in good condition.		Chain Guard: Conform to current specifications and securely fitted and in good condition	
Racesuit: Purpose designed for		Clutch Guard: Conform to current regulations and metal plate fitted between seat and clutch
