FROM THE TECH TEAM

Aug Spotlight on Rules,

4.2.45 On-kart cameras & communications

Camera(s) are required from the beginning of the 2025 season.

Following the Warwick round, this is a timely reminder to all competitors regarding the requirement for operational in-car cameras. During the event, the Stewards requested footage to assist with the review of several on-track incidents. Unfortunately, in a number of cases the requested footage was unavailable because cameras were either not fitted, not switched on,.

As outlined in the Auskart Racing regulations, competitors are responsible for ensuring their camera is fitted securely, fully charged, switched on, and recording before entering the circuit. Camera footage is an important tool in helping officials make fair and informed decisions when reviewing incidents. Please take the time before each event to check your camera's operation and recording capacity. Failure to provide requested footage when directed by the Stewards may result in penalties in accordance with the regulations.
