2.2.6 Championship Points System

All racing members must volunteer 2 hours Minium during the Championship(s) session to be eligible for full championship points. Failure to supply direct or indirect volunteers support (team member or parent/guardian) hour will result in an additional round (second lowest) dropped championship points.

Task could include but not limited to, set up support, pack up support, Fuel rig, Endurance desk presentation support etc and will be recorded by membership officer and Vice President.
